### **Lead Service Line Replacement – Phase 1 and Water Tower No. 1 & 24-inch Transmission Main Projects**

Construction of the City of North Chicago's Lead Service Line Replacement, Water Tower No. 1, and Transmission Main projects were financed by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's (IEPA) Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The Public Water Supply Loan Program is administered by the IEPA and received a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. These projects include the replacement of approximately 177 lead water service lines at various locations in the City of North Chicago as well as the construction of an elevated 750,000-gallon water tower and water transmission main. Once complete it will improve water quality, water system pressures, flexibility and overall system reliability for area residents and businesses in the City of North Chicago. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities with the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
